

Dear Friends of the Great Hound of Ireland -

The Irish Wolfhound Association of the Delaware Valley will hold its Thirty-Seventh Annual Specialty Show on Sunday & Monday, October 8 & 9, 2017, at our show site just off of the Pennsylvania Turnpike northwest of Philadelphia. The Holiday Inn Morgantown, 1/2-mile South on Rt.10 from PA Turnpike Exit 298, will again be our headquarters hotel, and as last year, the showgrounds are 4-1/2 miles North on Rt. 10 at St Benedict Church's Picnic Grove. Try Google Maps - the address: "4540 Pennsylvania 10, PA" will put you at the entrance to the showgrounds. Make your reservations soon, as our reserved blocks of rooms can be held only until September 18th. Be sure to mention to the hotel that you are with the IWADV, or they may say that there are no rooms left because some dog club or other (IWADV!) has taken a block of rooms.

Early Closing - entries will close September 13th, the **fourth** Wednesday prior to the Specialty.

Don't forget the IWADV raffle. Be sure to see the display of IW items you might win. Raffle tickets, at \$1 each or six for \$5 are enclosed for those who may be unable to attend but still want to participate. If entering by mail, please respond to the address shown on the ticket. The winning tickets will be drawn immediately prior to the Best of Breed class on Monday, October 9th.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Single Dog Entries

Winners of the following classes will compete for Best of Breed and therefore must meet all AKC requirements for Non-Regular Classes involving single dog entries.

FIELD TRIAL DOG CLASS – Must have earned an AKC Field Championship, Senior Courser title, an ASFA Field Championship or LCM.

FIELD TRIAL BITCH CLASS – Same requirements as for Field Trial Dog Class.

VETERAN DOG CLASS – A Class for Dogs seven (7) years or older.

VETERAN BITCH CLASS – A Class for Bitches seven (7) years or older.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dog and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS – Two dogs of the same Breed or Variety of Breed with at least one common owner. Note that this is a relaxation of the previous AKC rule regarding "identical" ownership.

TEAM CLASS – A Class for four dogs of the same Breed or Variety of Breed with at least one common owner. As with Brace Class, this rule was recently revised by the AKC.

The entry fee for a Brace or a Team as a UNIT is \$25. The dogs comprising a Brace or a Team must be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace or Team is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace and/or Team Class Only", fee \$25 per such dog, plus \$25 for the UNIT. Full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and as part of a Brace or Team must be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes "Brace Class" or "Team Class". If more than one Brace or Team is entered by the identical owner, the dogs comprising each Brace or Team must be so designated – "Brace No.1" and "Brace No.2", etc.

Closing Date for Entries is **12:00 Noon, Wednesday, September 13, 2017** after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or changed, except as provided for in the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

All Entries are to be Mailed with Fees to David C. Milne, IWCA Show Secretary, 150 Creek Road, Phillipsburg, NJ 08865. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable after closing by mail with printed confirmations of entry. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary.

Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules are not acceptable.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

Declination of Entries. The Irish Wolfhound Association of the Delaware Valley may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Irish Wolfhound Association of the Delaware Valley or any official thereof.

Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn in U.S. dollars, **payable through U.S. banks** or with international money orders in U.S. funds.

The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The IWADV and the Show Secretary have no obligation or responsibility to provide service through a public address system or other means for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

This event may be cancelled due to extremes in weather or other conditions considered to be deleterious to the health and safety of dogs, exhibitors, judges and fanciers. No refund of entries will be made in such case.
