The event will be held on Saturday, October 7, 2023, the day before the Specialty.



CARDIAC TESTING - IWF LIFE CYCLE CARDIAC STUDY & OFA CERTIFICATION

The Irish Wolfhound Foundation is sponsoring heart screening with on-site cardiologist on Sunday, October 8, 2023. (EKGs available on Saturday afternoon, October 7th). A contribution of \$200 per hound (\$100 for hounds over 7 years old and affected dogs) for echocardiogram with electrocardiogram (EKG) or \$60 for auscultation and EKG is suggested. NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Single Dog Entries

Winners of the following classes will compete for Best of Breed and therefore must meet all AKC requirements for Non-Regular Classes involving single dog entries.

VETERAN DOG CLASS – A Class for Dogs six (6) years or older.

VETERAN BITCH CLASS – A Class for Bitches six (6) years or older.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dog and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS – Two dogs of the same Breed or Variety of Breed with at least one common owner. Note that this is a relaxation of the previous AKC rule regarding "identical" ownership.

TEAM CLASS – A Class for four dogs of the same Breed or Variety of Breed with at least one common owner. As with Brace Class, this rule was recently revised by the AKC.

The entry fee for a Brace or a Team as a UNIT is \$25. The dogs comprising a Brace or a Team must be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace or Team is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace and/or Team Class Only", fee \$25 per such dog, plus \$25 for the UNIT. Full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and as part of a Brace or Team must be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes "Brace Class" or "Team Class". If more than one Brace or Team is entered by the identical owner, the dogs comprising each Brace or Team must be so designated – "Brace No.1" and "Brace No.2", etc.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – SHOW REGULATIONS NOTE EARLY CLOSING! -- 6 YEARS-OLD FOR VETERANS!

Closing Date for Entries is 8:00 PM, Wednesday, September 13, 2023 after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or changed, except as provided for in the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

All Entries are to be Mailed with Fees to David C. Milne, IWCA Show Secretary, 150 Creek Road, Phillipsburg, NJ 08865. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable after closing by mail with printed confirmations of entry. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary.

Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules are not acceptable.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents and an Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. These Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, these Fees are to be collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2).

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

Declination of Entries. The Irish Wolfhound Association of the Delaware Valley may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Irish Wolfhound Association of the Delaware Valley or any official thereof.

Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn in U.S. dollars, **payable through U.S. banks** or with international money orders in U.S. funds.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Errors on Entry Forms: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts or conditions beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Consult Judging Program for time of judging.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judges Are Not Required To Wait For Dogs. They will adhere as closely as practicable to the Judging Program. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The IWADV and the Show Secretary have no obligation or responsibility to provide service through a public address system or other means for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

This event may be cancelled due to extremes in weather or other conditions considered to be deleterious to the health and safety of dogs, exhibitors, judges and fanciers. No refund of entries will be made in such case.

The Show Committee has designated the hotels as part of the show site. An Event Committee hearing may be held for any hotel complaint including but not limited to failure to clean up after your dog and destruction of hotel property.

The show giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

All trophies must be claimed before the closing of the show. None will be mailed. **The Club reserves the right** to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
